Buildings (including land within its curtilage) with A1, A2, A3, A5, B1, D1, D2 or betting office or pay day loan shop (sui generis) uses are permitted to change use for a single continuous period of up three years to A1, A2, A3, B1 and D1 (a,d,e,f or g) uses.

Land use change is a process by which human activities transform the natural landscape, referring to how land has been used, usually emphasizing the functional role of land for economic activities. Land use changes are often nonlinear and might trigger feedbacks to the system, stress living conditions, and threaten people with vulnerability.

In the UK, it is a legal obligation to obtain land use consent, and a Change of Use can apply if you want to change, for example, retail premises to residential premises, or storage premises to retail premises. The important consideration when looking at a Change of Use is ensuring that your Change of Use planning application is carefully considered to ensure that it has the best prospects of success.

Use Classes. The Town and Country Planning (Use Classes) Order 1987 (as amended) puts uses of land and buildings into various categories known as 'Use Classes' which are detailed below. 'Change of use' can occur within the same use class or from one use class to another.

Land use change simply refers to the conversion of a piece of land's use by humans, from one purpose to another. For example, land may be converted from cropland to grassland, or from wild land (e.g. tropical forests) to human-specific land uses (e.g. palm oil plantations).

If you live next to a parcel of agricultural land, paddock land or a field and would like to use it as part of your garden or for other domestic purposes, you will require a planning application and planning permission. This is because it constitutes a material change of use, as set out in section 55 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
